<p><u>ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies & Spanish</u></p> <p><i>Homework:</i> 15 % (a minimum of 15 assignments per quarter; a minimum of 5 graded for mastery)</p> <p><i>Classwork Rubric:</i> 15 % (graded quarterly, ongoing documented data collection throughout the quarter)</p> <p><i>Graded Classwork:</i> 10 % (a minimum of 3 tasks per quarter)</p> <p><i>Tests/Quizzes/Projects/Performance Tasks:</i> 60 % (no one assessment to carry weight of more than 20%; criteria/rubric with clear explanation of grades must be evident as applicable)</p>	<p><u>G.S.*, Computer & Health</u></p> <p><i>Homework:</i> 10 % (a minimum of 5 assignments, a maximum of 10 per quarter; a minimum of half graded for mastery)</p> <p><i>Classwork Rubric:</i> 20 % (graded quarterly, ongoing documented data collection throughout the quarter)</p> <p><i>Graded Classwork:</i> 20 % (a minimum of 3 tasks per quarter)</p> <p><i>Graded Tasks:</i> 50 % (no one assessment to carry weight of more than 20%; criteria/rubric with clear explanation of grades must be evident as applicable)</p>
<p><u>Physical Education*</u></p> <p>Grades are based on classwork rubric as follows:</p> <p><i>Participation in whole class discussions/activities:</i> 20%</p> <p><i>Participation in small group/pair discussions/activities:</i> 20%</p> <p><i>Completion of independent tasks:</i> 20%</p> <p><i>Preparedness:</i> 20%</p> <p><i>Commitment to Learning:</i> 20%</p>	
<p><i>Acceptable Grades:</i> 55, 60, 65 and single point grades from 66 to 100. Grades of 60 are not permissible in MP5. Grades of 65 and above are considered passing.</p> <p>*Students must attend G.S. or Physical Education 3 times per week to receive a numerical grade. Students that attend 1 or 2 times per week will receive a P (“pass”)/F (“fail”) grade. (<i>Grades 65 and above constitute a P.</i>)</p>
