From the Desk of the Executive Director

Dear Friends of The De La Salle School,

My predecessor, Brother Thomas P. Casey, FSC often spoke of the dilemma to move forward with the Feasibility Study committee that resulted in the decision to open The De La Salle School. The meeting had been scheduled for 12 September 2001, the day following the terrorist attacks on our nation. At a time of great uncertainty and confusion, these men and women came together and following that star of hope they courageously took a stand for the future and The De La Salle School was born. The De La Salle School opened its doors in September of 2002 and this year we began our nineteenth year of providing a quality Catholic Lasallian education to young men from families with economic challenges on Long Island. When Brother Thomas turned the helm over to me he said; "Trust in God, he will provide."

We once again find ourselves in a time of uncertainty and confusion due to unknowns associated with COVID-19. On Friday, 13 March 2020, we closed our doors and we began virtual learning. This was a new experience for most of our faculty and students. With determination and perseverance, we successfully completed the school year and sent another class off to High School. Throughout the summer months a series of plans were developed and prepared in hopes that the State of New York would once again allow us to welcome students back into the building. In the middle of August we received word that we could bring students back to the building if social distancing protocols and sanitizing procedures were followed. We immediately went into high gear and were fully prepared to accept students for the start of the new school year. Following a hybrid model, that incorporates both in class lessons and online learning, students returned to the building in September and are following a rotating schedule with a few families choosing to remain totally virtual.

Our ability to hold fundraising events and our general solicitation of funds was severely hampered by the COVID-19 restrictions. Our Gala needed to be cancelled and our ability to meet with potential donors was non-existent, yet if you follow the financial report our balance sheet demonstrates the generosity of our donors and benefactors. Technology has been a challenge for our families, but through the generosity of several of our benefactors we have been able to ensure that each student has the hardware necessary to navigate online classes and three of our class rooms received new SMART TV's in order to provide the teachers with the tools they need to present relevant lessons to the students.

As we begin this new and challenging chapter in the history of our school, we do so with a tremendous sense of gratitude. Many people are surprised to hear that a school like ours exists on Long Island. Thank you for your part in this ongoing miracle that we call The De La Salle School where hearts are touched and the world is being changed one student at a time. Your generosity has sustained us during a very difficult time in our history and we can't express the depth of our gratitude. Much of the credit goes to the people who allowed us to follow that star of Hope and who have been listed in this financial report. May God Bless each of you and keep you safe!

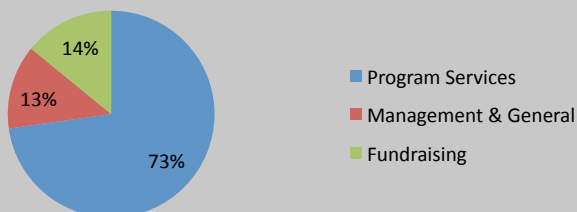

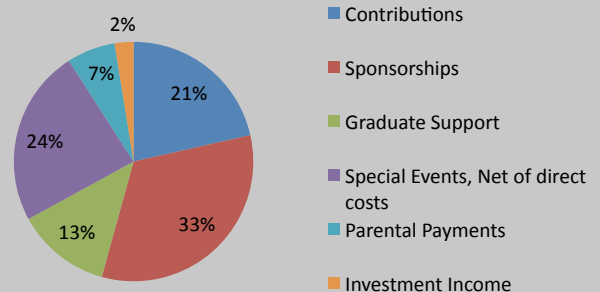
