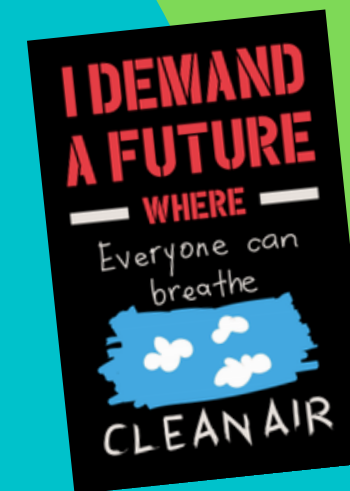

The Census occurs every 10 years, it is mandated by the Constitution and counts every person in the United States, regardless of citizenship, national origin or immigration status. Every person counts including babies! The Census count determines congressional representation and how approximately \$675 billion a year are allocated to our communities. The information collected is completely confidential, and the individual results will not be released to the public for 72 years
