Snap Facts:

Mathematic facts help students build a strong foundation for deeper conceptual understanding. Math fact fluency is the ability to state the answers to basic math facts automatically and without hesitation. Students gain fact fluency through substantial practice and this is why we want our students to know these facts in a SNAP!

Directions:

- 1. You may begin at Level 1 or you may choose a higher starting level (depending on your grade).
- 2. Throughout the course of a few days, study from the study sheet. One way to study is to create flash cards of each fact!
- 3. When you are confident that you know all the facts, take the quiz. Each quiz must be completed in 4 minutes so be sure to set a timer!
- 4. Have an adult, friend or sibling check your answers.
- 5. If you have 0 or 1 answer wrong, you may move to the next level and begin the process again!
- 6. If you have more than 1 answer wrong, continue studying and try again when you are ready!
- 7. You should not move to the next level unless the previous level has been mastered.
