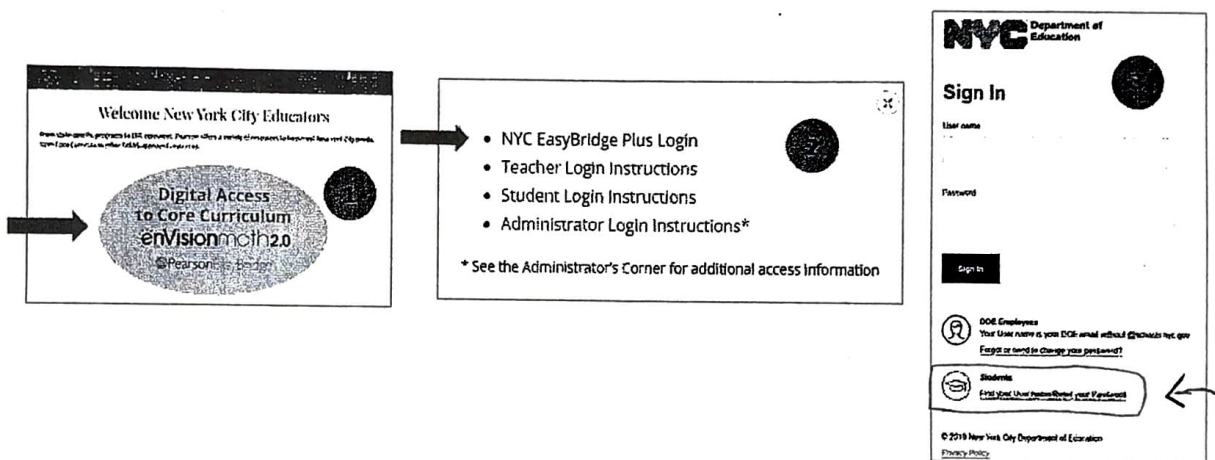

Student Access to enVisionmath2.0 via EasyBridge Plus

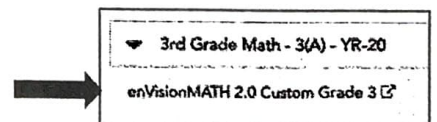
Sign in to Pearson EasyBridge Plus

Accessing your enVisionmath2.0 requires just a few steps. Follow the instructions below to get started and ask your teacher if you have any questions.

1. Go to Pearsonschool.com/nyc.
2. Click the yellow *Digital Access to Core Curriculum* button.
3. Click the **NYC EasyBridge Plus Login** link. You will be redirected to a login page.
4. Enter your student username and password. EasyBridge will open a new tab in the browser.
