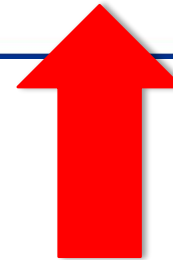

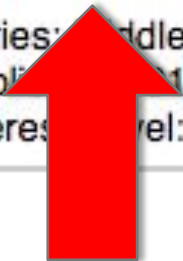

NON-FICTION BOOKS

- **FACT BASED BOOKS**
- **IN ORDER BY NUMBER AND THEN AUTHOR'S LAST NAME**
- **CAN BE FOUND ON VERTICAL SHELVES**

FICTION BOOKS

- **STORIES, PURPOSE IS TO ENTERTAIN**
- **IN ORDER BY AUTHOR'S LAST NAME**
 - **EXAMPLE: FIC FIT**

BIOGRAPHIES

- **A BOOK ABOUT A PERSON**
- **IN ORDER BY LAST NAME OF AUTHOR (SOMETIMES IT IS NOT THE PERSON!)**
 - **EXAMPLE: B JOB**
