SENIOR EXAM EXEMPTIONS

Qualified students in their senior year at Arthur L. Johnson High School may be provided the privilege of being exempt from final exams. A qualified student must have met the following requirements for each separate course to be exempt.

- Has achieved an “A” grade (B+ in AP courses) or better for each of the marking periods of their senior year in the subject area
- Has achieved a minimum of a “B” on the mid-term assessment for full year course.
- Has been reviewed by the administration for negative behavior or suspensions
- Has no outstanding school debts, books, athletic equipment, or school issued property
- The teacher at his/her discretion may not permit exam exemptions for a particular course provided students are notified of this policy in advance (prior to the final marking period) and is applied to all students in the class equivalently

The process to calculating final grades for students who are exempt from final marking period assessment will be as follows: 1. The average for marking periods one through four (one and two or three and four only for semester courses) will be recorded as the Final grade by the subject teacher; 2. The final average for the year will be calculated electronically using the above data.

Exemptions

There are only exam exemptions for seniors. Please consult the student handbook for the criteria. Seniors exempt from exam session one on a particular day, must report to the cafeteria by 9:55 a.m. to take the second exam. If he or she is exempt from the second session, the senior must report to the IMC. If a student is exempt from both exams in one day, the student will report to IMC by 11:30a.m. that school that day.
