Carl H. Kumpf Middle School's first annual school-wide Color Run/Walk Charity Event will take place on Tuesday, June 19, 2018. We have selected Ronald McDonald House as the charity this year. To partake in this portion of the event, students **MUST return a signed permission slip**. There is additional information about the powder and what to expect on the next page. ## Things to Know

- **Can all students participate?** The Color Run/Walk is only a part of the Activity Day; Students can partake in the other activities even if they have not donated or if they do not wish to have powder tossed at them; Students can bypass the color toss portion of the event if they choose.
- **What do I wear?** If you raised enough money, you will receive your t-shirt that you ordered. If not, we recommend you wear a bright white (old) shirt. The colors will show best on white. Wear old shorts, socks, and shoes. The powder washes out of most clothing, but you do not want to take a chance of ruining good clothes. The powder can stain some material. 100% cotton clothing is recommended and typical machine washing with stain remover, removes the stains. Excess color powder should be removed before washing.
- **What will be provided?** The PTA will provide all students with glasses and a bandana to wear during the Color Run/Walk. This will prevent the powder from getting into your eyes and to keep it out of your hair or mouth/nose.
- **Will the dye wash out of my hair?** The powder is made of colored cornstarch and is designed to be 100% washable and should wash out with soap and water. Using a “leave-in” conditioner also helps in removing the color from your hair.
- **Is the Color Powder Safe?** The powder is made of US FDA approved cornstarch and dye. All materials are 100% FD&C and/or D&C grade and approved by the US FDA. However, the product is not designed for consumption. Our goal is for everyone to be safe!
- **How does the color affect the inside of cars?** You may bring old towels for students to sit on in your car. The PTA will also have garbage bags for students to sit on for the bus or your car.
- **Will students have access to the building after the Color Run?** Students will go outside at approximately 10:00 a.m. and will be dismissed from outside. Students should not bring anything with them outside (including books and backpacks). If students bring anything with them outside, we will keep it in one location, but the less they have the better. There will be one set of bathrooms open for students to use once they have gone through the Color Run portion. There will be no building access after dismissal.
- **Will there be any food?** Yes, the PTA will provide drinks, pretzels, and other refreshments for the students.
- **When will students be dismissed?** Students will be dismissed at the normal Early Dismissal Day time of 12:32 p.m. They will be dismissed from outside after the school-wide Color Toss!
- **Can I still donate to Ronald McDonald House Charity?** While it is too late to order a t-shirt, we are still taking donations for our charity – Ronald McDonald House. If you still want to donate, put the donation in an envelope and mark it Charity Run Donation (if by check, make it payable to Clark Board of Education) and give it to your child’s homeroom teacher or bring it to the main office.
