



CODING for COUGARS

Coding for Cougars is an after school activity available to students in grades 6–8. The program will introduce Kumpf students to “coding” and how to improve computer skills and knowledge. Students will learn to code in Python, a professional programming language, making the skills learned relevant and applicable to many careers. Kumpf teachers will guide students through each concept and sample projects using a coding and computational thinking approach. Projects will include video game design and graphic design simulations.

Who can sign-up? All students in grades 6–8 may sign-up though enrollment is limited to fifty students. It is highly recommended that students in grade 6 have a strong background in math to get the most out of this program.

When will the classes take place? Coding for Cougar classes will be held after school from 2:45 to 3:45 p.m. The dates are listed below for the Fall Session. There will be an additional session held in the spring with the dates TBD. Each session will consist of twelve (12) one hour sessions. Students will also have access to the computer program license at home.

Is there a cost to register? Yes, there is a cost of \$75 for the Fall Session of Coding for Cougars. Checks are made payable to Clark Board of Education and enrollment is limited. If a student enrolls for the Spring Session there will be a reduced cost for that session for any student who completes the Fall Session. The cost includes all necessary materials and license permissions.

How do I sign-up? Complete the attached permission slip and return it to the main office no later than October 10, 2017 with a check made payable to the Clark Board of Education for \$75.00. Enrollment is limited.
