

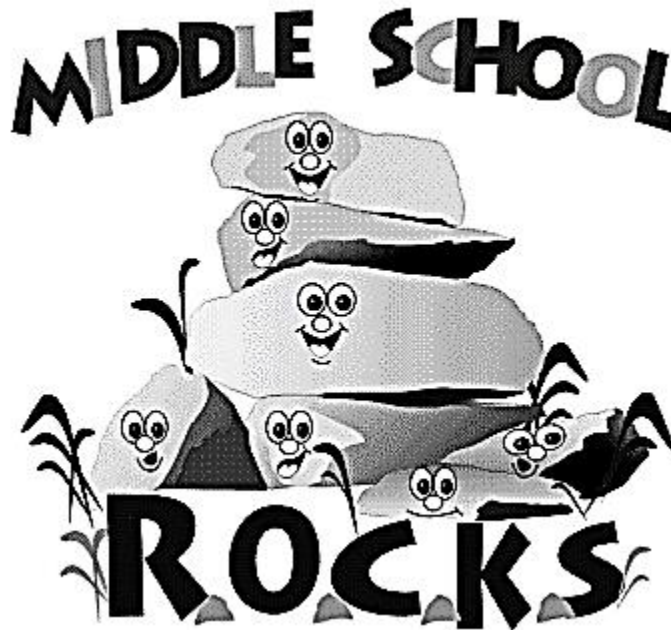

STUDENT DANCE RULES

The dances are a fun place for the students to socialize outside of the classroom environment. The following are rules for the dances that all students and parents should be aware of:

- Dances are from **7:30 p.m. until 9:30 p.m.**
- There is a \$5.00 admission fee per student which helps pay for the DJ, drinks and other student activities.
- **Dress appropriately.** Dances are a school function, the dress code does apply.
- **THE DANCES ARE OVER AT 9:30 p.m. Students will not be dismissed until the end of the dance.** Please do not come into the dance looking for your child early.
- **NO CELL PHONE USE INSIDE THE BUILDING.** Phones, if being used, will be confiscated until the end of the dance.
- No glow sticks of any kind are permitted.
- No ball playing, except in the gym. No opening or touching the lockers.
- No outside food, water bottles or other beverage containers will be allowed into the dance. Any water bottles or other beverages brought to the dance will be discarded. Refreshments are provided.

STUDENTS MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE SCHOOL

They are not allowed to leave the curb without a parent or guardian. Please drive down to the curb or park and wait by the building. We will not permit them to meet you elsewhere.
