

**The Elementary Science Fair**  
**Thursday, February 28, 2019**

This year's combined elementary science fair will be held in the cafeteria at ALJ from 7:00 – 8:00 p.m on Thursday, February 28. It is an exciting, non-competitive time for students to learn about scientific methodology. With help and guidance from their parents, students in grades 3 through 5 will present student-prepared scientific projects. Choosing a project should be done carefully with parental guidance. The project should be exciting to the student without being too complex to understand. Ideally, the project should focus on a student finding the answer to a question that is not known or fully understood by the student, prior to the experiment. Do not attempt to explain scientific concepts in detail that are beyond the student's understanding! The purpose of the fair is to allow students to experience the fun of scientific exploration. **IT IS ONLY FUN IF IT MAKES SENSE TO THE STUDENT!** Older students may be able to predict the outcome of the project based on the hypothesis about the phenomenon under consideration. The results of the project should provide, at least in part, an answer to the original question (conclusion).

**NOTE: NO FIRE OR EXPLOSIVES! NO LIVE ANIMALS! NO LATEX!**

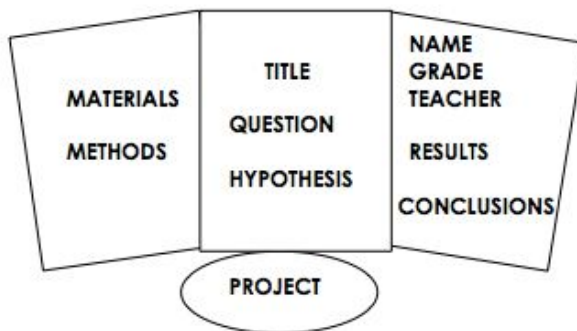
If your project involves a liquid, bring clean-up materials with you.

All projects should include the following headings:

TITLE	Topic of Project
QUESTION	What you want to find out
HYPOTHESIS	What you think will happen
MATERIALS	What you used
METHODS	What you did
RESULTS	What happened
CONCLUSIONS	What you learned

On the night of the fair, each presentation should be accompanied by a summary of the project on a display board using the format shown below.

**NOTE: ALL CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 15 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT**
