Dear Katonah-Lewisboro Families:

The Katonah-Lewisboro School District is pleased to announce that in the 2017-18 school year we will be including text messages to parents in selected Connect-Ed communications, including closings, delays and early dismissals.

Over the summer, we will be updating our Connect-Ed records with the ability to send a text/SMS message to each cell phone number that we currently have stored in the student system.

Once the phone number settings have been updated, we will send a test text message, giving you the opportunity to let us know if the message is not received.

You may opt-out of this service by:

- Contacting the Technology Department (via an email to [connectedsupport@klschools.org](mailto:connectedsupport@klschools.org)) by Friday, July 28, specifying which numbers should not be included in this service;

Or

- At any point after you have received the first text from the system (including the test message), typing STOP KLSD in response to the text. The service will be discontinued for only the phone number from which the STOP KLSD was sent.

If you elect to opt-out of the service, and then decide to re-start it, you can text SUBSCRIBE KLSD to 23177 or 63079.

Additional information will follow when we have determined the exact date of the test.
