**REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS: March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 BY 12:00 PM.** Registrations after this date, if accepted, will not be pro-rated and will have to wait until the following week from the date of registration to begin class. **All club fees must be PAID before your child can attend any club.**

# CLUB DESCRIPTIONS

## **Art:**

Students will develop their creative abilities through literary works. They will share and reflect on their art to learn about themselves, each other, and the world around them-all while having fun!

## **Basketball:**

Students will learn to play basketball and compete with in groups.

## **Bricks 4 Kidz:**

This is a hands-on class where students build educational models using LEGO® bricks. Some models may utilize, rubber bands, motors and batteries. Classes are 1 hour once a week.
