Reading

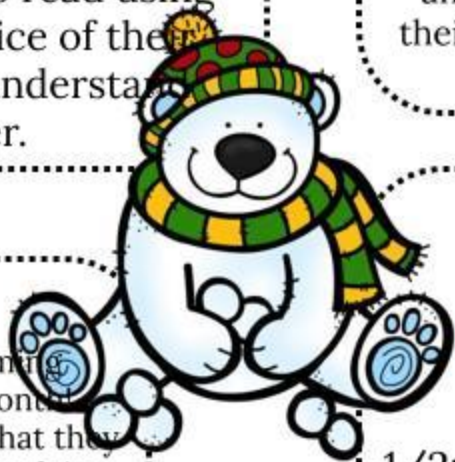
In Reading workshop, second graders are busy reading fiction books thinking about their characters, the problems they face and how they are solved. Students are continuing to work on reading fluently and with expression. Students are encouraged to read using punctuation and in the voice of the characters to help them understand their books better.

Writing

Students are writing about their reading, by writing opinion letters that tell their reader about what traits their characters have. Second graders are working on giving reasons for their ideas and using examples from their books to back up their thinking.

Math

Mathematicians are becoming subtraction experts this month. Students are now putting all that they learned from Chapter 5 to work in Chapter 6, where they are adding to subtraction strategies and refining the concepts already learned. Students are focusing on closely reading word problems and thinking about which operation the question is asking them to complete.
