



Process for the Selection of Members for the Superintendent's Equity Council

On December 18, 2019, the Superintendent created a nominating committee consisting of the district's two licensed special education providers, the district's ELL coordinator, and three staff members representing the Free and Reduced Lunch Program, STARS reporting, and the district business office.

This committee will convene on January 6, 2020 and will be provided a list of students with disabilities, a list of English Language Learners, and a list of students qualifying for free lunch (as a proxy for economically disadvantaged status) and will be asked to nominate two students and two parents from the lists, provided that none of these nominees may be a current district employee nor an immediate family member of any current district employee.

The committee will also be asked to nominate one school leader, one staff member, and one community member to serve on the equity council.

On January 13, 2020, the Tatum Board of Education will be asked to consider approving these seven nominees, appointing the two students and two parents to serve 3-year terms on the council and appointing the three other nominees to serve 4-year terms on the council.

Tatum School's Board of Education met on January 13, 2020 and approved the following nominees to the Superintendent's Equity Council.
