IMPORTANT: TURN IN ALL 4 DAYS OF WORK AT THE SAME TIME!

Do your work on your own notebook paper, or type onto a word document.

- A. **Monday, May 11th** – Write a one paragraph (about 7 to 10 sentences) about how the Coronavirus has affected and influenced your life. Use your daily life and routines, friendships and family relations, school, your family's work (if you want to share) and how it has affected you personally, and even spiritually and physically. Important: List some things that you have lost obviously because we all have, but also list something that you learned or something positive that came from this crisis!
- B. **Tuesday and Wednesday, May 12th and 13th** – Making predictions: Predict how you believe school will take place when it begins again in the fall using one of these three scenarios listed below. Choose which one you believe will happen, and explain in two or three sentences or statements why you believe this way. Use all that you have learned about the CV when considering your choice. THESE ARE ONLY MADE UP EXAMPLES, BUT I HAVE READ OF SCHOOLS CONSIDERING ALL OF THESE OPTIONS, AND MORE, WHEN THEY BEGIN. NONE OF THESE HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED AS WHAT TATUM WILL DO!
1. School will resume in August, just as it always has, with school taking place exactly like it always has including sports. Students will physically attend school, go to classes, eat in the cafeteria, ride buses, play sports etc. just like normal.
 2. School will resume in August, just as it always has, BUT will take place online only until the first semester is over due to continued spread of CV. There will be no fall sports. Winter sports (basketball) will be the first school sport to

take place. Students will resume actually going to school in January after Christmas break and then things will be normal.

3. School will resume in August, just as it always has, and we will actually attend school physically, but school will be started at different times, some coming at 8 am, some at 10 am and some at noon. Students will leave at different times of the day as well. There will be a shortened school day. This is to make sure that the school is never “full” at any one time. Sports will resume but only for those athletes and coaches who have been tested for CV.
