

## Social Studies - Recurring Assignment for Each Week

YOU are living in historic times! Like Anne Frank who kept her diary while hiding with her family during the Nazi occupation of the Netherlands, your assignment will be to keep a journal/diary to write entries daily (3-5 per week) to keep a record of what you are experiencing during the Covid-19 Pandemic of 2020 from your point of view.

You may make your diary from loose leaf paper, use a spiral or composition book, use a blank bound book you might already have available, do a blog or even a vlog using video to do this assignment.

Other pointers to make your journal/diary an accurate historical record:

- Give your journal/diary a creative name
- Your first entry will be the longest as you share where we are today and how we got to this point.
- You will need to date every entry of your journal/diary
- Remember, this will be a great way of expressing your feelings as well.
- Be as creative as you choose to be.

Remember, this will be a historic record of YOUR experiences that you may share with your children and grandchildren someday! Who knows, maybe years from now some class may be reading your journal/diary as a class assignment!
