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**Dear Pre-K and Kindergarten Families,**

We are excited to announce that we have been given permission for our youngest learners to attend school on a more consistent basis. This is possible because of the smaller class sizes in Pre-K (18) and kindergarten (25).

Yesterday we sent out a survey asking parents if they would like their Pre-K and K students to attend more often if possible and the response was overwhelmingly positive!

Therefore, we will now use Model 1B for **Pre-K and Kindergarten** (see below). Model 1B allows us to have two cohorts of students with a 2 day/3 day cycle of in-person learning. (Grades 1-8 remain with model 2 which has 3 cohorts of students)

In order to reconfigure cohorts, we had to collapse Cohort C. Therefore, all Pre-K and K students in Cohort C will be assigned a new cohort. However, to best support families, **Cohort C students with siblings** were placed into Cohort B so that they can still attend school with their Cohort C siblings on Fridays. Some changes may occur to schedules on Mondays and Tuesdays. We apologize in advance for any scheduling changes. The benefit of more in person time for our youngest learners is driving this decision.

- Cohort A remains Cohort A
- Cohort B remains Cohort B
- Cohort C will be reassigned to either Cohort A or Cohort B
