

Grading Policy 2018-2019

The PS/MS 114 grading policy entitles all students to a fair and equitable evaluation of their work.

Report cards are issued three times each year. The grade for each marking period will reflect the teacher’s evaluation of the work during that marking period. The final grade is a reflection of the students’ academic performance for the entire school year.

Home Work	Any work assigned to be completed at home

Late and Make Up Work Policy
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All students are permitted to make up missed classwork and homework. • It is the student's responsibility to make up missed work. • If students are absent, they have a two day window to submit missed work for full credit. After two days, grading deductions will be applied. (3rd day - minus 5 pts., 4th day – minus 10 pts, etc...) • If a student is present for class and does not hand in homework, students have two days to submit missed work with grading deductions for lateness applied. (1 day – minus 5 pts, 2nd day – minus 10 pts. etc...)
