Learning Management Platform - **iLearnNYC**

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1. In your address bar, type **iLearnNYC.net**
2. Scroll down the page and click on the blue **Sign-in** button
3. If you have not yet set up your child's DOE credentials, click [Find your User name/Reset your Password](#) next to the orange student button at bottom of page.
4. **Enter your 9-digit Student ID (OSIS) number** to get your user name and/or reset your password. (You will only need to do this the first time you log in)
5. Sign into iLearnNYC
6. Your child's teacher will teach them how to navigate the platform to find their work.

Note: We are still in the process of programming students and getting them set up on iLearn. Teachers have not yet posted any work.
