Digital library for children 12 and under.

Free for parents for 30 days. Teachers are free until June 30.

Fiction, Non-fiction, videos, audio books and books in Spanish.

If teachers have an account students can log in with their class code.

MyON

Students can log in with username and password from school.

News-O-Matic is now being offered, included some current events.

Variety of genres for children to read.



Online Resources to Utilize

IXL:

IXL is an online resource that uses insights from student initial diagnostic in the curriculum to generate personalized guidance for each learner to practice. These personalized action plans link students to the skills that will help them build on their knowledge, remediate gaps in understanding and accelerate their learning.

*Students login using username and password from school

* Concepts; Math, Reading, Writing, Social studies, and Science.


*Smartscore- a skill is mastered when the student reaches a score of 100.

Khan Academy

* Student can practice grade level or learn new math skills.




Prodigy
