INSTRUCTIONAL/PERSONNEL COMMITTEE: (Mr. Ficetola)

1. Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board appoints Nicholas Annitti as Financial Consultant to the Board for the period of July 19, 2017 until October 31, 2017, or until further action of the Board or until the appointment of a permanent Business Administrator. Nicholas Annitti shall be paid \$75.00 per hour for up to fifteen (15) hours per week at the discretion of the Superintendent.

4. Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board approves the service contract with Supreme Consultants to perform interpreting services for a max of 20 hours at a rate of \$47 per hour for the 2017-2018 extended and school year.
