Dear Neighbor,

During these unprecedented and uncertain times, your Mayor and Council have been diligently working to keep our residents, first responders and borough employees safe from the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic locally.

Today, Governor Murphy instituted new protections to address the rising number of COVID-19 cases statewide and in Bergen County:

Statewide

- By order of the Governor, a statewide curfew will be in place from 8pm to 5am effective immediately and until further notice.
- Additionally, all bars and restaurants will be closed as of 8pm on March 16th except for takeout, until further notice.

In Carlstadt

- The Carlstadt Public Library will be closed until further notice.
- Carlstadt Municipal Court will be suspended until April 6th.
- The Senior Bus will be available for food shopping trips only. No mall trips are planned.
- Overnight Parking rules will be suspended until March 30th.
- Alternate side of the street parking rules will be suspended until March 30th.
- All public parks, playgrounds and basketball courts will be closed until further notice.
- Borough Hall will be closed to the public, but employees will be at their desks to service you. Please call for assistance. Tax Collector, 201-939-1779. Court Administrator, 201-438-4306. Building/Zoning Department, 201-939-1777. Borough Clerk, 201-531-7180.
