Dear Parent(s) and Guardian(s):

On Thursday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, our students and staff will be sharing some Halloween festivities here at Carlstadt Public School.

All of Mrs. DelMauro, Mrs. Rizzo and Ms. Forte's afternoon Pre-K students should plan to arrive to school wearing their costumes.
