



Primary Materials for Pre-k Remote Learning

- 1- name card (First name and last name: provided by teacher for daily sign in)
- 1- folder (refer to original supply list online)
- 1 box of 24 Crayons
- 1 scissor (blunt tip/ child size)
- 3-Pencils (chubby to begin for some)
- 1 pack of 12 #2 Pencils
- 1 box-Markers (washable)
- 1-Glue stick (small)
- 1 bottle of glue
- 1 pack of construction paper
- 1 pack of white paper
- Play-dough
- 1 Small bag of sand
- 1 (2-3 cup_ plastic container to store sand)

Blocks or boxes made from:

- Cereal/ pasta/tissue boxes
- Any packaged small boxes (amazon)
- Toilet paper rolls
- Paper towel rolls

Counters

- Pennies
- Small rocks or shells
- Sticks
- Bottle tops from containers (milk, orange juice, etc..)
