1. Go to [TeachHub](#) .
2. Sign in with their [DOE account](#) credentials.
3. Click the dark blue iLearnNYC icon.
4. You should be signed in automatically. Once in iLearnNYC, you can teacher, review course content, and more.

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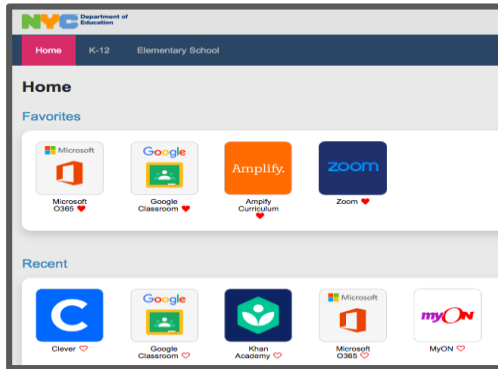

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

The [Student Account Self Service](#) tool helps students and families obtain account info and reset passwords

What if I don't have my DOE account information?

1. Go to [Student Account Self Service](#)
2. Enter your **9-digit Student ID number**. (You can find your Student ID number on a report card, your student ID card, or in your [NYCSA](#) account.)
3. Enter your **birthday**.
4. Click **Continue**.
5. If the information you enter matches your student record, your username will be displayed.
6. Your student ID is your username followed by @nycstudents.net. For example, if your username is JaneD, your student account ID is JaneD@nycstudents.net
