

## **Fourth Amended Public Notice**

May 6, 2020

*NOTE: This notice has been amended to include details regarding how and when members of the public may access and participate in the Panel for Educational Policy meeting at which this proposal will be voted on. Those details are contained in the first and final section of this notice.*

### **THE PROPOSED OPENING AND CO-LOCATION OF A NEW SITE OF AN EXISTING DISTRICT 75 SCHOOL, P.S. X188 (75X188), WITH URBAN SCHOLARS COMMUNITY SCHOOL (12X463) AND NYC AUTISM CHARTER SCHOOL BRONX (84X587) IN BUILDING X198 BEGINNING IN THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR**

#### **I. Description of the subject and purpose of the proposed item under consideration.**

This notice has been amended a fourth time to reflect that, due to technical difficulties encountered at the Panel for Educational Policy Meeting (PEP) scheduled for April 29, 2020 at 6:00 PM, the regular public meeting of the PEP has been rescheduled to May 7, 2020 at 6:00 PM. This notice has been further amended to update the new link for the PEP vote teleconference to <https://learndoe.org/pep/may7/>.

No changes have been made to the original Educational Impact Statement (EIS) or Building Utilization Plan (BUP) for this proposal, posted by the New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE) on February 14, 2020.

The NYCDOE is proposing to open and co-locate a new elementary school site of the existing multi-sited District 75 school, P.S. X188 (75X188), to be called P188X@X198, in building X198, referred to as X198, beginning in the 2020-2021 school year. X198 is located at 1180 Tinton Avenue, Bronx, NY 10456 in Community School District 12, referred to as District 12.

A co-location means that two or more school organizations are located in the same building and may share common spaces, such as auditoriums, gymnasiums, libraries, and cafeterias.

Urban Scholars Community School (12X463), referred to as Urban Scholars, and NYC Autism Charter School Bronx (84X587), referred to as NYCACS Bronx, are currently co-located in X198 with P.S. 212 (12X212), an existing district elementary school serving students in grades K-5 and in a pre-Kindergarten (pre-K) program. Urban Scholars is an existing district elementary school serving students in grades K-5 and in a pre-K program in X198. NYCACS Bronx is an existing ungraded charter school that serves students diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) in X198. X198 also houses the community-based organization (CBO) East Side House Settlement.

In a separate EIS, the NYCDOE is concurrently proposing to merge P.S. 212 with Urban Scholars in X198 beginning in the 2020-2021 school year. A merger means that two or more



existing school organizations are combined into one school to operate and serve students more effectively. The implementation of this proposal is contingent on the PEP's approval of both this proposal and the concurrent proposal to merge P.S. 212 with Urban Scholars. These proposals will be voted on separately by the PEP. If both proposals are approved, P188X@X198 will be co-located with the merged Urban Scholars and NYCACS Bronx in X198 beginning in the 2020-2021 school year.

This notice was originally amended on March 22, 2020 to reflect that the Joint Public Hearing previously scheduled for March 17, 2020 at X198 was rescheduled to take place on March 24, 2020 via teleconference.

This notice was amended a second time on April 13, 2020 to provide the updated format for the PEP meeting where this proposal will be voted on.

This notice was amended a third time on April 20, 2020 to reflect that the regular public meeting of the PEP, originally scheduled for April 22, 2020, had been rescheduled to April 29, 2020 at 6:00PM and to update the new link for the PEP vote teleconference.

## II. Information regarding where the full text of the proposed item may be obtained.

The EIS and BUP are available in the main offices of P.S. 212, Urban Scholars, NYCACS Bronx, and P.S. X188, however, at this time, due to the impact of COVID-19, most school buildings are closed, with the exception of those providing essential services.
