

# Remote Summer School 2020 Calendar

(Updated May 20, 2020)

This summer, all learning will take place in a remote environment. The table below summarizes the calendar for each summer school program type.

Student Group	Student Calendar	Typical Schedule
<b>Special Education (D75, ESY)</b>	Wednesday, 7/2–Thursday, 8/13	Monday–Friday, 8:30am-2:30pm
<b>High School</b>	Monday, 7/6–Friday, 8/14	Monday–Friday, 8:30am-1:30pm or a similar five-hour day
<b>Grades 3-8 who are not promoted in June and are required to attend summer school</b>	Monday, 7/6–Tuesday, 8/11	Monday–Thursday, 8:30am-12:30pm or a similar four-hour day
<b>Grades 3-8 who are promoted but recommended for additional academic support</b>	Monday, 7/6–Tuesday, 8/11	Monday–Thursday, 8:30am-12:30pm or a similar four-hour day

Please note:

- The last day of school year 2019–20 is **Friday, June 26**.
- The DOE will accommodate holidays for Independence Day and Eid al-Adha on **Friday, July 3** and **Friday, July 31**.
- The DOE will provide two days of remote professional learning for elementary, middle, and high school teachers. All teachers must participate in professional learning, even if they have taught Summer in the City, on **Wednesday, July 1** and **Thursday, July 2**.
- The DOE will provide 30 days for District 75 and ESY special education programs. Teachers will receive one day of remote professional learning on **Wednesday, July 1**. Instruction for students begins on **Thursday, July 2**.
- Elementary and middle school teachers will have two days at the end of summer school to review promotion portfolios on **Wednesday, August 12** and **Thursday, August 13**.
