

Yorktown Elementary School Student Clubs

Yorktown Elementary School offers various after school clubs. This year, many of the clubs will be offered on the same afternoon and follow a rotating schedule for grade levels. This allows students to have the opportunity to participate in all of the clubs. Below is a detailed description of each club being offered.

The three clubs being offered on Wednesday are Student Council, Literature Club, and F3. All three clubs will meet on the first two Wednesdays (some changes for breaks, etc.) after school until 3:30 pm. Below is a detailed description of each club.

Literature Club

Literature Club is a combination of studying novels, comics, and other literature options. This year's sponsors are Mr. Kerkhoff, Mrs. Swander, & Mrs. Cahoe. Cost for Literature Club is \$10. This covers the cost of purchasing one book and other materials needed. There will be guest readers, working in groups, and hands-on projects. We will host a Read-A-Thon at the end of the school year.

Student Council

All Yorktown Elementary students are invited to join student council. Student council members represent the voice of the student body and are leaders throughout the school. They help organize community service projects, sponsor and arrange school wide special activities, and provide help throughout the school when needed. The sponsors for Student Council are Mrs. Boone and Mrs. Stephenson.

Fit, Fun, & Fabulous (F-3)

This club is to entice students to learn different ways to exercise. Students will race against themselves only. Some of the agenda includes yoga, scavenger hunts, and other activities. Some of these activities may take place at Morrow's Meadow (when weather permits). The F3 sponsors are Mrs. Gard and Mrs. Oetting. Cost is \$10 for this club to cover the purchase of supplies and materials.

Student Pick-Up Information

We will be using the Y.E.S. student pick-up procedures for our Y.E.S Club pick-up. We will have many children getting picked up at the same time, so we ask for your patience during this time. Here is a description of this procedure.

1. Y.E.S. has offered car tags that will hang on your rear view mirrors. Families were given 1 tag at the beginning of the school year. **If you have not received a car tag, please indicate this on the bottom of this form. We will make sure to provide you with a tag.** Please put your child's FIRST and LAST name(s) on

the tags, and have them in your window. This will help us speed up the pick-up procedure.

2. When picking up your child, parents will line up at the student pick-up door. We will use the same procedures as student drop-off and pick-up.
3. Parents will need to enter this line from SR 32, not through the Y.M.S. All parents will need to stay in their place in line. This line may get long at times, but understand that this is for our student's safety and to make sure the line runs smoothly.
4. Staff will identify which students go to the first 4-5 cars in line. When these cars pull up, the next 4-5 students will be identified and brought to the cars. This will keep the line moving in one direction, without cars having to pull out in the middle.
5. All parents will need to stay in their cars during this time. Students will be waiting with staff for your car to pull up to them. You will need to have your car tag displayed in the window. This will allow staff to see who you are picking up and bring your child to you.
6. When a child is getting into the vehicle, it is safer and quicker for all children to get in on the passenger side of the car. If a child has to go to the driver's side of the car, please make sure an adult stops traffic to ensure your child's safety.
7. It is important for parents to be cautious while they are in the pick-up line. We ask that parents **do not** use their cell phones while driving through the line.
