SCHOOL PROFILE 2017-2018

Notre Dame High School is a four-year co-educational Catholic High School serving the greater Easton, Pennsylvania and Phillipsburg, New Jersey area. An enrollment of 508 is divided into college prep, AP, honors, and vocational-technical curriculum for grades 9 through 12. The school year is divided into two semesters of 18 weeks each, with nine-week reporting periods. The school is supervised by the Allentown Diocese Department of Education and is accredited by the Middle States Association and the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

The school is comprised of students from four surrounding Pennsylvania counties and two counties in New Jersey. It has a broad socioeconomic background and varies in character from urban to suburban. The community is mostly residential with several commercial and light industrial areas.
