Dear Parents:

Welcome to 5th Grade! Your child will need the following supplies for this school year. If you chose to purchase your school supplies with **First Day School Supplies**, the items below will arrive at your home. If you did not, then you will need to purchase the supplies below. Please note the DONATED SUPPLIES we are requesting. They are a necessity in the classroom. When sending in supplies, **PLEASE FOLLOW** the schedule below so that students can easily carry in the supplies themselves.

Please send the following supplies to school on Thursday, September 5th:

- 14 folders (4-red, 2-dark blue, 2-light blue, 2-white, 1-gren, 1-orange, 1-purple, 1-yellow)
- 10 marble notebooks

DO NOT LABEL FOLDERS OR NOTEBOOKS

- 4 pre-cut tennis balls
- 1 package of pencils
- 1 art box (5.6" X 8.4" X 2.5") filled with 24 Crayola crayons, Crayola markers, colored pencils, Elmer's glue bottle
- 1 pencil case filled with 2 highlighters, 5 **sharpened** pencils, 2 red pens, 2 blue/black pens, pencil sharpener, scissors, 1 scotch tape, 2 glue sticks, 1 dry erase marker and eraser, post-its

Please send the following supplies to school on Friday, September 6th:

- 1 flash drive labeled in baggie
- 1 pack construction paper
- 2 packs of loose leaf (Wide Ruled)
- index cards
- Donated Supplies (See list below)

The following supplies are necessities and would be greatly appreciated by the classroom teachers.

Please send these donated supplies to school on Monday, September 9th:

- 2 packs of computer paper
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- Ziploc Bags:

 - Quart Size – Boys

Any extra supplies should be kept at home and used to replenish your child's personal supplies throughout the year.
