Welcome to 4th Grade! When sending in supplies, **PLEASE FOLLOW** the schedule below so that students can easily carry in the supplies themselves.

Please send the following supplies to school on Thursday, September 5th:

- 12 Wide Ruled Composition Books – Black Marble-100 Count (**Label** with Child's Full Name)
- 12 Pocket Folders-Bottom Pockets (2 red, 2 yellow, 2 blue, 2 green, 2 orange, 2 white) **Do not label**
- 24 #2 pencils, sharpened, latex free
- 4 Elmer glue sticks
- 5 rolls of Scotch tape
- 1 large zippered pencil case
- 1 box Crayola crayons-24 count
- 1 legal pad (yellow lined)

Please send the following supplies to school on Friday, September 6th:

- 5 pack of highlighters
- 2 red pens
- 1 child friendly scissors
- 1 12-inch plastic ruler with both inch and centimeter markers
- 4 Dry erase markers **BLACK** only
- 1 Crayola colored pencils-12 Count
- 1 Crayola Washable Markers Classic Colors-8 count
- 2 packages of copy paper -white- 500ct ream
- 1 package of **wide ruled** loose-leaf paper
- **Girl:** Assorted Colors Cardstock 50 count **Boy:** White Cardstock-100 count

Please send the following supplies to school on Monday, September 9th:

- 1 box zippered storage bags, gallon size
