Daily Work:

Projects:

Routines:

1. The students will find instructions on the board, to begging their work right away (Do now)
2. Attendance is taken(5min)
3. The students will continue working in their Do Now routine (10min.)
4. Mini Lesson (15 min.)
5. Practice (15 min.)
6. Exit ticket (5 min.)

Tests and Quizzes:

- Tests will be given at the end of every chapter.
- Quizzes are formal and informal and can be announced or unannounced
- Students must be ready to be assessed at all times
- Informal quizzes can be written or verbal

Attendance
