Our Learning Goals

Math: We are getting into more challenging math, working with groups of numbers, repeated addition, writing numbers in words, expanded notation, place value, and skip counting. Practice addition and subtraction facts and doubles facts whenever you can!

Writing: We are diving into informational writing, learning about informational text, so we can report on information we learn. Ask your little one about their favorite things to learn about so they can research and present information to their classmates.

Reading: We are building our stamina to read longer, harder books independently. Keep reading at least 20 minutes every night and writing about the book to help your little one with their comprehension.
