We have had a great start to the second semester! We appreciate the support our community has shown by sending students to school every day on time, ready to learn and staying the entire day.

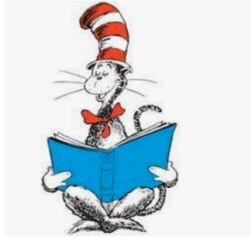
Testing: WOW! Our students did amazing on their DIBELS and WY-TOPP assessments. Students in every grade level saw amazing growth. Students will review their scores and set goals for the remainder of the year. We can't thank you enough for supporting reading, writing, and math at home.

Homework: At Stagecoach we really try not to send home "useless or frustrating" work. When teachers send homework there is a purpose. Your student earns house points for reading minutes and mastery of math facts. Please take time to read with your child nightly (this counts towards minutes read). By reading nightly, not only does your child earn house points, fulfill reading minutes, but you increase your child's vocabulary and quality family time! Math fact mastery is crucial for further math understanding. If your child has not mastered their addition and subtraction facts by the end of 2nd grade they will fall behind in 3rd grade and beyond. If your child does not have multiplication mastered by the end of 3rd they will be behind in 4th grade. If your child does not have division mastered by 4th grade they will be behind in 5th. At Stagecoach we are increasing academic rigor to ensure your child will be successful not only in Wyoming, the United States, but also globally. We thank you for your support in our efforts to ensure every child is successful.

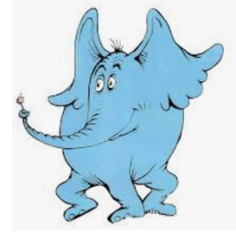
