

## SUPPLY LIST GRADES 1 AND 2 FOR 2020-2021

Dear Parents: to cut down on how much you have to buy, we recommend that you use last year's materials as much as possible. If you want to take advantage of Labor Day Back to School sales, that's fine, but if you want to wait to see what is still usable, we want you to have that option as well. The following list includes materials for Art. PLEASE LABEL ALL MATERIALS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME SINCE NO MATERIALS (except paper towels) WILL BE SHARED.

Crayola Classic Thick Markers 10 count  
Crayola Classic Fine markers 10 count  
Crayola colored pencils 12 count

5" blunt scissors  
4 pens \* SECOND GRADE ONLY\*

### REMOTE LEARNING
