

Dear Fifth Graders and Parents:

Welcome to the fifth grade. The following is a list of supplies that must be bought prior to the first day of school in September.

EACH STUDENT MUST HAVE THESE ITEMS:

- 2 Perforated Canary Writing Pads, **8-1/2" x 11-3/4"**
- 6 (**strong**) folders – Required colors: **Red, Blue, Green, Yellow, White, Orange**
- 4 marble notebooks
- 10 black or blue ink ballpoint pens
- 24 sharpened **Ticonderoga No. 2 Pencils**
- 2 red pens or pencils
- 1 Sharpie Permanent Black marker
- 2 yellow highlighter markers
- 2 packages of **lined** sticky notes
- A 12" ruler displaying both metric and standard measurements
- A **small** (no larger than approximately 5" x 8") labeled art box which holds the following supplies: crayons, markers, 2 rolls of tape, stick glue, 1 bottle liquid glue and scissors.
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 package/box of baby wipes
- 3 sheets Avery 8160 labels (30 per sheet)
- 1 ream of white copy paper
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- 1 package pencil cap erasers (12 count or more)
- 1 Bottle Soft-soap Liquid Hand soap (7.5 oz)

- **\$9.00 for the American Heritage Dictionary** (If you already have a copy from a previous child, please bring it on the first day instead of the \$9)

- *1 Green Folder For science*
