First Practice permitted August 13, 2018 (Monday)

First Scrimmage permitted August 23 (Thursday) 8 Practice days for Team

First Game permitted August 24 (Friday) 10 Practice days for Team

Minimum Number of Contests To be eligible for sectional, intersectional or state competition, a team must have completed in six (6) school scheduled contests which occurred on six (6) different dates during the season.

Team Sports: An individual is eligible for the team if he/she has been an eligible participant on a team in that sport in that school for a minimum of six (6) scheduled contests during the regular season. For football, a student must be an eligible participant for a minimum of three (3) contests.

Team/Individual and Individual Sports: An individual must also have represented their school in six (6) scheduled contests during the season to be eligible. These required contests must occur on six (6) different dates and must be conducted prior to the conclusion. {NYSPHSAA Handbook, pg 104, #25 a}

Last day to play – October 16, 2018 (Tuesday)

Maximum Number of Contest: 16

CLASSIFICATION

Section One tournaments will be divided into groupings based upon the present New York State classifications. A school **may not** request to move up in class for Sectional competition. In the event of a two year realignment or longer, a school forced to move up or down in classification as a result of a change in BEDS enrollment will not be penalized. Their school's winning percentage will be used to determine their seeding.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

All tournaments will use a single elimination format to advance through the tournament.

FALL GIRLS SOCCER TOURNAMENT DRAW PROCEDURE

Upon receiving the Section One Tournament Application from schools wishing to participate in the tournament, a member of the Girls Soccer Committee will contact each Coach or AD with their seeding, game time and site.

Class AA-A-B-C teams must have their "SCOREBOARD" returned to BOCES and the Chairperson by **October 16, 2018 (Tuesday)**. If you have a game that day, you must call in SCORE to the CHAIRPERSON, Frank Mazzuca at 845-222-8273.

Also, ALL SCORES must be submitted Electronically to BOCES on "SCOREBOARD"

The following FORMS must be submitted to BOCES and the CHAIRPERSON in order to be eligible to compete in the SECTIONAL TOURNAMENT:

RULES FOR PENALTY KICKS

If the score remains tied after the completion of all prescribed over-time periods, all coaches, officials and team captains shall assemble at the halfway line to review the procedure as outlined below:

- a. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all of the penalty kicks shall be taken.
- b. Each coach will select any five players, including the goalkeeper, on or off the field (except those who may have been disqualified) to take the penalty kicks.
- c. A coin toss shall be held. The team winning the toss shall have the choice of kicking first or second.
- d. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow-up on the kick.
- e. Following five kicks for each team, the team scoring on the greatest number of these kicks shall be declared the winner.
- f. Add one goal to the winning team's score and credit the team with a victory. An asterisk (*) may be placed by the team advancing to indicate the advance was the result of a tiebreaker system.

If the score remains tied after each team has had five penalty kicks:

- a. Each coach will select five different players than the first five who already have kicked to take the penalty kicks in a sudden victory situation, wherein, if one team scored and the other team does not score, the game is ended without more kicks being taken.
- b. If the score remains tied, continue the sudden victory penalty kicks with the coach selecting any five players to take the next set of alternating penalty kicks. IF a tie still remains, repeat the above process (a).

NOTE: The above penalty kick rules apply for both Sectional and Regional games.

GENERAL SECTIONAL PROTEST PROCEDURE

General regular season protest:

Officials shall enforce the rules and their decisions on points of fact are final. The officials can only correct a decision so long as the game has not been restarted. Protests of NFHS rules are not recognized. The officials shall not use video replays to assist in any decision (Rule 5-1).

Sectional protest:

It is the responsibility of the Host school to have available a copy of the rule book for all sectional games.

Officials shall enforce the rules and their decisions on points of fact are final. The officials can only correct a decision so long as the game has not been restarted. Protests of NFHS rules are not recognized. The officials shall not use video replays to assist in any decision (Rule 5-1).

A Protest committee of three- the site-coordinator, the rules interpreter (official) and the sectional chair. The game may not restart until a final decision is rendered. Once a final decision is rendered, there is no right of appeal and the games proceed to its conclusion.
