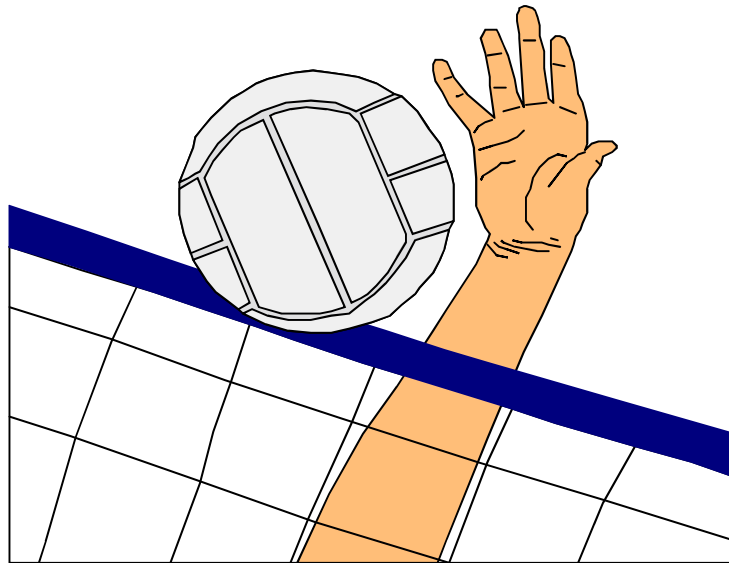

2018**

**First Practice** permitted Monday, August 13, 2018 (or Monday, Aug. 20<sup>th</sup>).

If beginning first practice on Aug. 20<sup>th</sup>, then your first scrimmage is 8/26 and first game is 8/28.

**First Scrimmage** permitted after 6 Practice days for Team – 4 days for Individual

**First Game** permitted after 8 Practice days for Team – 6 days for Individual

**Last Day to Play** Monday, October 22, 2018

**Minimum Number of Contests** To be eligible for sectional, intersectional or state competition, a team must have competed in six (6) school scheduled contests which occurred on six (6) different dates during the season.

**Maximum # of Contests: 20**

**Team Sports:** An individual is eligible for the team if he/she has been an eligible participant on a team in that sport in that school for a minimum of six (6) scheduled contests during the regular season. For football, a student must be an eligible participant for a minimum of three (3) contests.

**Team/Individual and Individual Sports:** Individuals must also have represented their school in six (6) scheduled contests during the season to be eligible. These required contests must occur on six (6) different dates and must be conducted prior to the conclusion. {NYSPHSAA Handbook, pg. 104, #25 a}

**CLASSIFICATION**

Section One tournaments will be divided into groupings based upon the present New York State classifications. A school may not request to move up in class just for sectional competition. In the event of a two year realignment or longer, a school forced to move up or down in classification as a result of a change in BEDS enrollment will not be penalized. Their school's winning percentage will be used to determine qualification for sectionals.

## ELIGIBILITY

1. All eligibility certificates, petitions, rosters and site forms must be faxed or emailed to your League Representative by **Wednesday, October 17, 2018.**
2. **All results of games played after emailing the petition, must be phoned in to the League Representative. The last game to count will be Monday, October 22, 2018. Please wait until your game is played before phoning in all of these results. Call your league representative on his/her cell phone.**
3. All schools must abide by eligibility regulations as set forth in the NYSPHSAA Handbook.
4. **Tournament games do not count toward Sectional records.** Please **do not** include them on your petition to enter Sectionals.
5. **NEW: In Team sports the JV & Varsity programs must have rated all officials from Section One who worked their games in order to be eligible to enter the tournament.**

## **SEEDING**

The Qualifying Standard & Seeding Criteria will be used to determine an index. The highest index will be the top seed.

## SITES

1. **Whenever possible,** all matches up to and including the Semi-Finals will be played at the site of the higher seeded team. In the event that your site form is not completed and mailed, or the Volleyball Committee believes that you have illegal or unsafe court(s), the match will be played at a neutral site with the approval of Sports Committee (as per Section One policy).
2. All sites should be available one hour before the scheduled start. Ball use is permitted on the court 30 minutes prior to contest.
3. The coach whose gym is being used will be responsible for reserving the gym and having it ready for warm-ups one hour before play is scheduled.

## HOST SCHOOL INFORMATION

If your school is a host for the 2018 Volleyball Sectional Tournament, there are several responsibilities we are asking you to fulfill in addition to the usual responsibilities that occur during seasonal play. The following is a list of these responsibilities and we ask that you **get as many volunteers as possible.** Also, it is assumed that your school will not charge any money for use of the facilities and any custodians that are needed for the event.

**Section 1**  
**Sectional Tournament Qualifying and Seeding Standard**  
**2018/2019**

**I. Qualifying Standard (to get into sectionals)**

Each team in all classes will qualify based on Points earned over the course of the season. Each sport will have a minimum number of points each team will need to qualify to get into sectional play. The points are based on wins, losses and ties along with bonus points earned due to strength of schedule.

<u>Maximum Number of Games</u>	<u>40% of total points from schedule</u>
*Sports with 16 game max <i>Field Hockey, Boys/Girls Soccer Boys/Girls Lacrosse</i>	$(16 \times 4 = 64) 64 \times .40 = \mathbf{26 \text{ points needed to qualify}}$

*Sports with 20 games max <i>Baseball, Softball, Ice Hockey, Boy's and Girl's Basketball (Varsity only)</i>	$(20 \times 4 = 80) 80 \times .40 = \mathbf{32 \text{ points needed to qualify}}$
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**\*Volleyball**-maximum number of games is 20, however due to tournaments the number of qualifying points used to determine eligibility is 16 games  $(16 \times 4 = 64) 64 \times .40 = \mathbf{26 \text{ points needed to qualify}}$  (as approved by Section One Athletic Council)

**To qualify for the Sectional Tournament: A team's winning percentage will be used from their entire schedule's record: all games count to earn qualifying points. Bonus points will be calculated and added at this point from only Section One schools to help qualify.**

**Points that can be used to meet qualifying standard:**

- Wins (4 points)-from all games played (in and out of state)
- Ties (2 points)-from all games played (in and out of state)
- Bonus points- **Can only be earned from Section One schools** and is determined from winning percentage of a team's entire schedule.

**\*Winning percentage process for qualifying:**

- Take wins, multiply by 1
- Take ties, multiply by .05
- Add the two values
- Divide by the total amount of games

Example: 7-5-4 record, wins  $7 \times 1 = 7$ , ties  $4 \times .05 = 2$   $9 / 16 = .563$

**Once a team has qualified, they are seeded by the process below:**

**II. Seeding (once team qualifies)**

At this point, **winning percentages are recalculated.** Winning percentages are **determined from only Section One games.** All other games are eliminated (**FEDERATION. CHSAA, AIS, PSAL, Out of State**)

\*Bonus points for seeding:

- Wins (4points) from all Section I games
- Ties (2 points) from all Section I games
- Bonus points determined from winning percentage of a team's schedule of Section I opponents only

**\*Winning percentage process for seeding-**

- Take wins vs Section I multiply by 1
- Take ties vs Section I multiply by .05
- Add the two values
- Divide by the total amount of games

*Example: 7-5-4 record, wins  $7 \times 1 = 7$ , ties  $4 \times .05 = 2$   $9 / 16 = .563$*

**\*Calculation of Index for Seeding:**

- Take the total number of points obtained in the seeding process from wins/ ties/ and Bonus points.
- This value is divided by number of games played in Section I

*Example: 10-4-2 record vs Section I gets the following points:*

- $10 \text{ wins} \times 4 \text{ points} = 40 \text{ points}$
- $2 \text{ ties} \times 2 \text{ points} = 4 \text{ points}$
- Add bonus points garnered, ex 10
- $\text{Index} = 40 + 4 + 10 = 54$
- $54 / 16 \text{ games played} = 3.375$

### **III. Tie Breaker Criteria**

1. Head to Head
2. \*Overall average of bonus points earned by the number of games played in Section I
3. Winning percentage
4. Common opponent (if they played same number of times)
5. Committee decision

\* 10 bonus points in 16 games in Section I =  $10 / 16$   
( $10 \div 16 = 0.625$  average bonus point per game)

10 bonus points in 18 games in Section I =  $10 / 18$   
( $10 \div 18 = 0.555$  average bonus point per game)  
0.625 is greater and would win tie breaker vs .555

### **IV. Appeals**

An appeal of a school's inability to qualify for the tournament will be accepted up to 24 hours prior to the seeding meeting. The only appeals considered will be districts that have an established policy not allowing teams to participate in a full schedule.

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED AS A HOST SCHOOL

1. COLLECT MONEY AND SUPPLY TICKET TAKERS - Your Athletic Director should have a hand stamp to use on tickets to sell at the tournament. **\$8.00** will be charged for the Finals. **\$5.00 for children 12 & under and Senior Citizens (62 and over).**
2. HOSTS FOR TEAMS AND OFFICIALS - You will need a few people to greet the participating teams as well as officials and show them the locker room facilities and game courts. Protocol for all introductions will include announcing all players and coaches and playing the National Anthem.
3. LOCKER ROOM AND LAVATORY FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS.
4. EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBERS - Please have the phone number of your local ambulance and police available in case of emergencies.
5. AN ACCURATE BALL PUMP.
6. Having a concession stand is up to you and your school.
7. An Athletic Trainer for all matches.
8. Water for both team benches.
9. Game balls – Spaulding ball is required.

## PRE-GAME INFORMATION

1. Participating teams are responsible for supplying one (1) new unmarked Spaulding official volleyball for their matches.
2. Each team will provide an experienced scorer and a Libero scorer. The higher seed will provide these officials.
3. Each team will supply its own first aid equipment.

## POST-GAME PROCEDURES

1. The **winning coach** is responsible for calling in the game results by 8:00 p.m. on the day of the match.

Classes B, C, and D please call Robin Cooke (914) 804-2396.
2. **Publicity**-All coaches will be responsible for calling their own papers and radio stations with results and facts about their match.

## **PROPOSED Standard Operational Procedures Girls Volleyball (for adoption Fall 2018)**

The official pre match protocol for ALL Regional play and State Championships is shown below. \*It is recommended that this protocol be used during Sectional play.

Neutral music should be used during warm up at all sites. Adults should be at the scoring tables, Neutral adults-when possible. Recommended - Officials should be on the lines from Sectional Finals and up.

It is recommended that teams arrive 45 minutes before match time. A team will not be allowed on the gym floor with volleyballs until 30 minutes before match time. Teams will be allowed on the floor to warm up/stretch prior to the 30 minutes without volleyballs. Official warm up is 22 minutes. Ten (10) minutes together, six (6) minutes serving team, 6 minutes receiving team.

### **Time Allotted Protocol**

Captains' meeting/coin toss

:30 minutes Game Court available to be shared for warm up with volleyballs

:22 minutes Official warm up begins

:10 teams on court together

:06 serving team has full court

:06 receiving team has full court

### **Match begins**

The official post-match "Awards Ceremony" should consist of: Team members line up on 10' line. Award and announce the Runner up team and present certificates and trophy (if one is to be given) and then award and announce the Championship team and present certificates and trophy.

## **NY STATE TOURNAMENT RULES AND PROCEDURES**

1. Official NCAA 2018 rules will be strictly adhered to, as well as the NY State committee's modifications.

2. Each team must provide a scorer and a Libero scorer through the semi-finals.

3. **PROTESTS:**

For all of sectional matches, protests must be lodged according to NCAA rules. If the match officials deem that the controversy is protest-able, a formal protest must be lodged (play will continue after the lodging of the protest); then the protest is called/delivered/faxed to the Section One Chair by 8 pm on the day of the protest. After reading the protest, the Section One Chair will confer with the Volleyball Official's Chair. The Section One Chair's decision will be final. If the protest is upheld, the match will be replayed on the next day, from the point of protest.

4. Ties for Round Robin Pool Play for State Tournament:

a. Teams shall not be eliminated from championship competition on a point system.

b. Teams qualifying for the playoffs but tied for position only shall not compete in a playoff game to determine position. Position assignment shall be determined by the point spread priority listed below:

- 1) 1<sup>st</sup> Priority: Results of the match between the tied teams; first on the won-loss record, and second on the point spread. If still tied, then...
- 2) 2<sup>nd</sup> Priority: Comparison of the point spread based on the total Round Robin competition. Point spread shall be determined by subtracting the total points lost from the total points won. The highest plus or the lowest minus remainder shall be considered the superior team for tie-breaking purposes.
- 3) 3<sup>rd</sup> Priority: Flip of a coin.

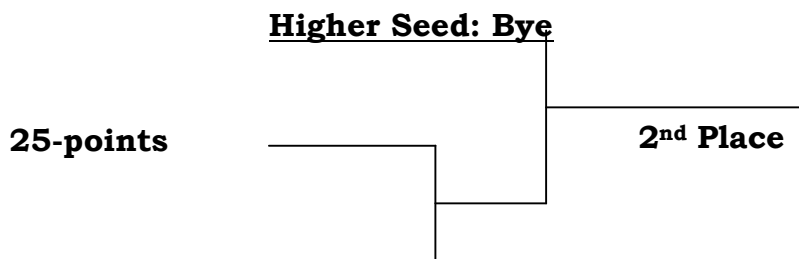
c. If two or more teams are tied for a single playoff position, at least one 25-point rally game shall be played. For example:

- Two teams tie for last position: play one 25-point rally game.
- Three teams tie for last position; the superior team determined by the point spread shall be the bye team and shall play the winner of the match between the two remaining teams. Total of two 25-point rally games are played.
- Four teams tie for last position: determining placement by the point spread system, Teams 1 and 4 and Teams 2 and 3 play each other, and winners' playoff. A total of three 25-point rally games are played.

## **NY STATE TOURNAMENT RULES AND PROCEDURES (cont.)**

d. If three teams tie for two playoff positions, the team with the greatest point spread shall be awarded first place, and the other two teams shall play one 25-point rally game for the remaining playoff position. The same priorities as listed in #2 are used, except that if a tie exists after the 2<sup>nd</sup> priority, a coin flip shall determine the bye team and all teams must play for position as follows:

- Team Blue wins over Team White and gains one playoff berth.
- Team Red plays the loser, in this case Team White, for the second playoff berth. Two 25-point rally games are played.
- If three are tied:



**5. The use of flash cameras during play is prohibited. Flash pictures may be taken during warm-ups only. Please inform all spectators/media of this to avoid delay during the match. An announcement should be made after the introduction of the players.**

### **State Tournament**

- A. At the State Pool Play Tournament, the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> round will have 18 minutes of warm-ups before the official warm-up of 6 minutes and 6 minutes for each team. After round 2, all warm-ups are 6 and 6.
- B. The pools of 4 – play each team 2 games of 25 points. Top 2 teams move on to the finals.
- C. A Digital team photo must be sent prior to the Sectional Semi-Finals or your team will not be in the State booklet.
