First Practice permitted November 5, 2018

First Scrimmage permitted after 8 Practice days for Team - 6 days for Individual

First Game permitted after 10 Practice days for Team - 8 days for Individual

Last Day to Play: Thursday, February 14, 2019

Minimum Number of Contests To be eligible for sectional, intersectional or state competition, a team must have completed in six (6) school scheduled contests which occurred on six (6) different dates during the season.

Team Sports: An individual is eligible for the team if he/she has been an eligible participant on a team in that sport in that school for a minimum of six (6) scheduled contests during the regular season. A student must be an eligible participant for a minimum of three (3) contests for Football.

Team/Individual and Individual Sports: An individual must also have represented their school in six (6) scheduled contests during the season to be eligible. These required contests must occur on six (6) different dates and must be conducted prior to the conclusion. {NYSPHSAA Handbook, pg 104, #25 a}

CANCELLATION PROCEDURE

First Round Games

1. Since games are held in “home” school gyms, cancellations should be handled the same as for a regular season game.
2. Make-up day **must** be the following day. Home school Athletic Directors are responsible for contacting traveling opponents, the Section office and the Section chairperson.
3. Decisions to postpone a 7:00pm game must be made no later than 3:00pm.
4. Decisions to postpone a semi-final or final round game and beyond will be made by the Section chairperson after consultation with the Section One office and the facility administrators.

TOURNAMENT DRAW PROCEDURE

1. Schools desiring to enter this year’s (2018-2019) Section One Girls Basketball Tournament must send their Player Roster, Season Result Form and Officials Rating Sheet to the Chairperson of the Section One Committee **NO LATER than February 14, 2019.**
2. If you submit the Game Reporting Sheet prior to your final game, then you are responsible for contacting Artie McCormack (201) 788-1262 or Chris Drosopoulos (914) 879-5016 with your scores. Failure to report scores will jeopardize your team’s seeding in the tournament.
3. The committee will meet on Friday, **February 15, 2019**, to determine the pairings, sites and other details of the tournament.
4. Game results through Thursday, **February 14, 2019**, will be considered in determining seedings. If you are playing that day, please report the score by 8:00p.m.

GAME CONDITIONS AND GUIDELINES

I FIRST AND SECOND ROUND GAMES

1. The Athletic Director of the home team shall ultimately be responsible for the administration of the game. Please use your accepted practice for a well-attended game as a guide in determining your personnel needs.
2. The host school shall be responsible for additional supervision for crowd control.
3. Superintendents, high School Principals, and Athletic Directors are to be admitted free, and are encouraged to identify themselves to the host director.

It is recommended that school districts serving as host sites charge for all Section One tournament contests. An admission fee will be charged for all Semi-Final and Final games. **\$8.00 Admission, \$5 Children 12 & under and Senior Citizens (62 and over).**

4. The home school shall supply a game ball, and experienced personnel to operate the scoreboard, official clock, and 30-second clock. Additionally, the home school will provide warm-up balls. No team will be allowed on the court with basketballs prior to the allotted time.
5. Locker facilities and adequate half-time room shall be available. The security of personal possessions will be each team's responsibility. Teams should bring their own locks to assure safekeeping of personal belongings. Schools must provide female chaperones for teams with male coaching staffs.

II SEMI-FINALS & FINAL GAME

1. The Section One Girls Basketball Committee will act as site host and will be responsible for conducting the games in accordance with the tournament guidelines.
2. The Section will provide an Athletic Trainer if neither school can obtain one. Schools must contact the Sectional chairperson to make the request.
3. The Committee will provide a scorebook keeper and all official table personnel.
4. The official warm-up will commence 20 minutes prior to game time. Teams will be guaranteed 20 minutes.
5. All local rules regarding the use of the site will be respected.
6. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each class final game.
7. Each team shall provide its own training supplies.
8. The higher seeded team is the home team and shall wear the home uniform (white or light color). The lower seeded team is the visiting team and shall wear away uniforms (dark color). Coaches are responsible for having teams in correct uniforms.
9. Home and visiting team designations include all privileges and responsibilities as found in the NCAA Rule Book.
