Please be sure to get a music teacher to measure your child for the appropriate size instrument before you purchase an instrument.
(Optional) Case to keep supplies in	Pencil	Reusable Write & Wipe Pocket (Sold at Lakeshore, Amazon & elsewhere)	Shoulder Rest or End Pin Anchor: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Violin and Viola students need a shoulder rest. This will help support the instrument on the body. Artino, Kun, and shaped shoulder sponges are all acceptable. • Cello & Bass students will need an end pin anchor. This will help stabilize the instrument's end pin on the floor so that it does not slip. End pin anchors with a strap that can be attached to the leg of a chair are recommended. An example of this type is the Xeros Brand. End pin anchors without a strap are also acceptable options.
