6. Mail notes home and/or emails from the faculty and staff
7. Uses of web related services such as JCAMPUS or other web based means.
8. Conduct parent grade-level meetings throughout the year such as testing or scheduling
9. Send invitations to parents for activities and ceremonies
10. Hold parent-teacher conferences, which may be initiated by the parent
10. Provide parents with progress reports and /or report cards every 4 ½ weeks
11. Invite community members for Veteran's day program and other community events



