2nd Offense – Office Referral and 1 day ISS, confiscate device

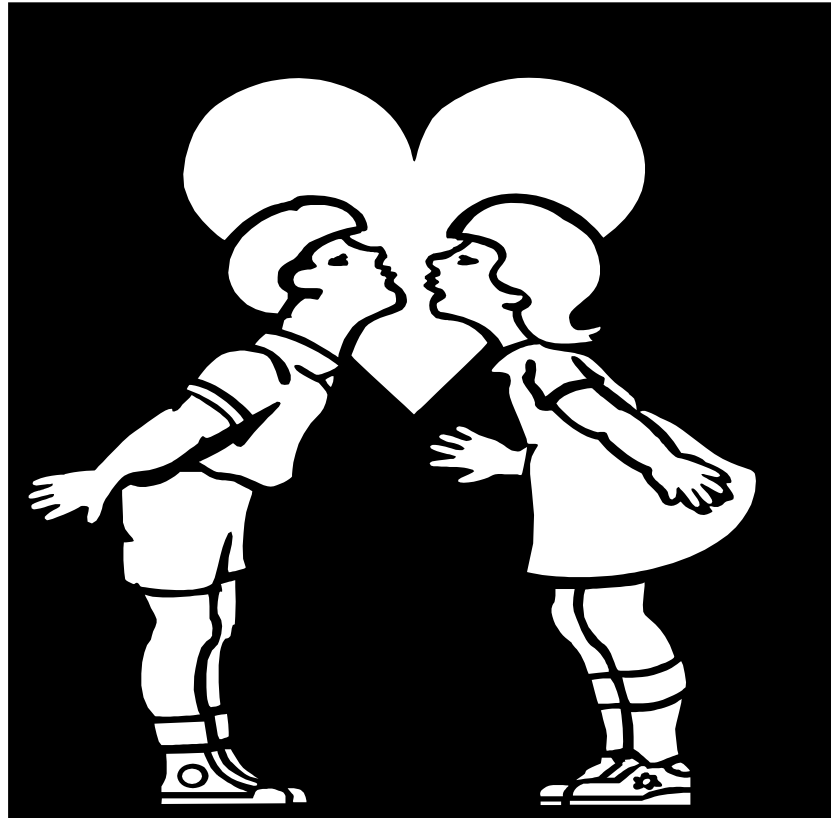
3rd Offense – Office Referral and 2 days ISS, confiscate device

Cell phone on/visible in a red zone

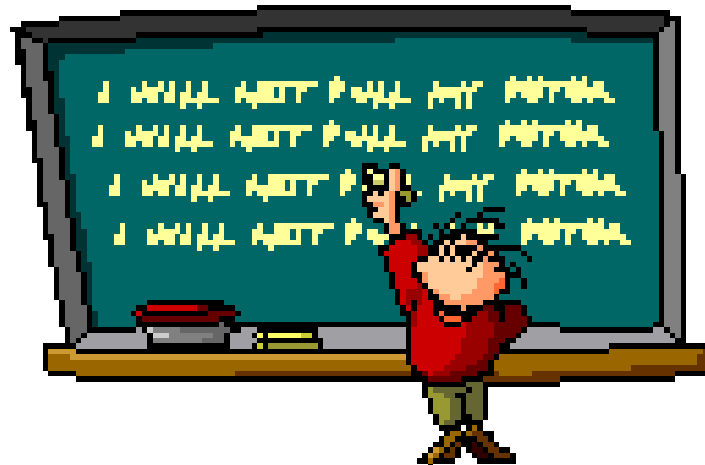
- Your parent will have to report to school to sign for your cell phone.

- School consequences given according to code of conduct.

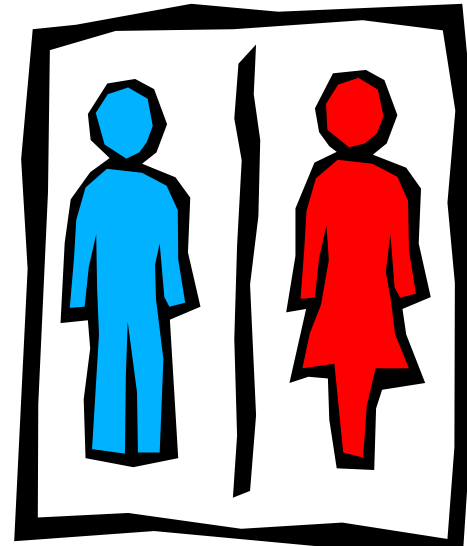
Show respect for yourself, others, and property.
