PRESENT:

Chairman Bert Broadwell, Vice Chair Dale Gilchrist, Michael Alewine, Kent Bryant, Jeff Ford, Benjy Sorrow and Peggy Lee Waters. Also present was Deirdre McCullough and Bill Moser.

ABSENT:

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Broadwell called the meeting to order at 5:04 P. M.

INVOCATION:

Mrs. McCullough gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Mr. Broadwell led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Broadwell stated there was a need to make changes to the Agenda. Mr. Alewine suggested we move down, change the order of the Agenda.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

There was no one present for Public Comment.

APPROVAL OF LAST MONTH'S MINUTES:

Mr. Alewine made the motion to approve the minutes of the July 13, 2010 meeting. He was seconded by Mrs. Gilchrist. Motion passed unanimously.
