Code of Conduct and Dress Code for St. Ignatius CYO Dances

We want all students to have good, safe fun! Please read the following and sign if you would like your child to participate.

- NO BACKPACKS or other bags are allowed. They will be confiscated and need to pick up by a parent.
- No tobacco, alcohol, or drugs
- Cell phones are only permitted at the registration area and are to be used only in an emergency. There are NO warnings. If a student is found using their cell phone, the cell phone will be confiscated.
- You have to be a CYO 6th, 7th, or 8th grade student from St. Ignatius or invited Berks Catholic feeder school.
- You are allowed to invite up to two guests after providing guest information below.
- No foul language is allowed.
- Respect others and obey all chaperones.
- Any physical contact that is not considered dancing is not permitted.
- Dress appropriately. **See dress code list below.**
- No mosh pits.
- Do not go onto the stage unless invited by the DJ for a game or activity.
- Respect school property. Do not damage or take anything not belonging to you.
- No hanging out in the bathrooms. Please take turns.
- Prescription medication cannot be administered by dance chaperones.
- No one is permitted to leave until the dance is over. If a parent needs to pick up a child prior to 9:45 PM, we require that you come in and sign your child out at the door. Otherwise, students will be dismissed to the parking lot at 10:00 PM. We appreciate your promptness. Instruct your child to return to the building if you are late. We want all children to be claimed safely and properly.

<p>All dances: NO short shorts, cut-off shorts, boxers, worn jeans with holes, exposed midriff, back or cleavage; NO halter tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops, muscle shirts, hats, caps, Heelie shoes, skates; NO laser lights, glow in the dark items, or clothing that advertises alcohol, tobacco or drugs, or clothing with obscene/offensive messages</p>	<p>Sports Themed dance: Dress in your favorite sports team apparel. NO equipment such as helmets, bats, hockey sticks, rackets, balls, etc. Hats and caps are allowed for this dance only. Prizes will be given for the most spirited students.</p>	<p>Semi-Formal: Semi-formal dress is defined as: slacks, collared shirts, buttoned dress shirts, jackets, ties, skirts, blouses, dresses, sweaters. Undergarments are not to be seen. Overcoats must be removed after entering the building and placed in the designated area. Only small handbags will be permitted. Strapless dresses or dresses with spaghetti straps will require a sweater or shawl to be worn throughout the dance.</p>
